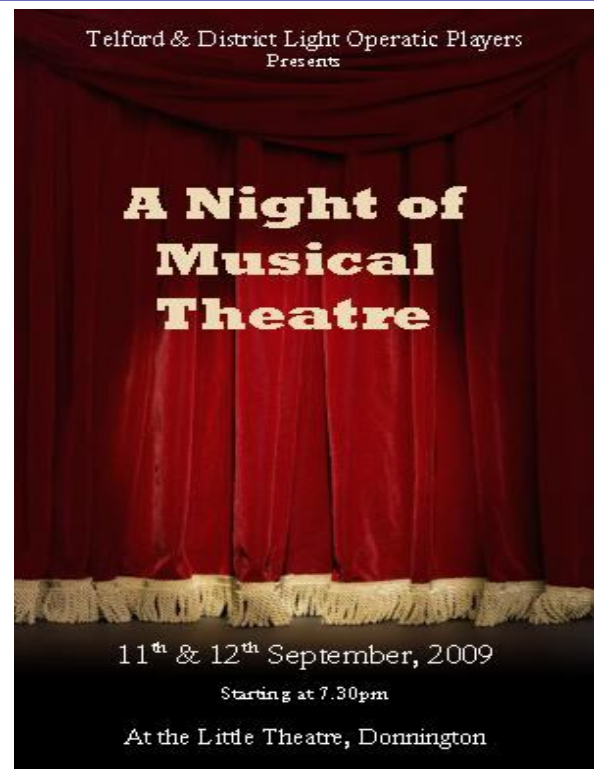
THE VOICES OF THE PEOPLE
